Rising 13U KUBA Golden Knights Travel Baseball Team Are Hosting Tryouts!

The 13U KUBA Golden Knights Travel Baseball Team is hosting tryouts for the 2025-2026 season. The team is open to anyone who was born on or after May 1, 2012. Tryouts will be held in July at the Kennett High School baseball field located at 100 East South St in Kennett Square. One of the main goals for this team is to transition serious, youth baseball players to the full size 60'/90' baseball field as well as prepare them to play middle school and high school baseball. The team will be run by an experienced 4-5 member coaching staff. The head coach had a well decorated playing career with many individual accolades and team championship wins. That has been followed with 12 years of coaching at the high school level with multiple team championships. A number of players from those teams competed at the collegiate and professional level after graduation. Head coach is also certified in Driveline Baseball Academy training. Coaching staff will also employ a second coach with experience coaching at the high school level. The larger coaching staff will allow for more individual instruction on a positional level for both practices and games. All coaches and team personnel pass an annual background check.

KUBA, which stands for Kennett Unionville Baseball Association, is based out of Kennett Square and provides baseball players 21 and under an opportunity to play competitive travel level baseball. KUBA has a strong reputation for the quality of play, talent, teaching, and facilities. This has lead numerous players to numerous championships at all age levels along with players graduating to play at local high schools and colleges as they mature.

The Fall 2025 schedule will consist of 2-3 times a week of either practices or games. The early part of the Fall season will be heavier on practices to prepare for the successful transition to the full size field. The game schedule will increase over the Fall as players acclimate and run through the first week of November. Winter workouts will be at KUBA indoor baseball training facility in Kennett Square 1-2 times per week beginning in January and go through mid-March. The travel season will be light through mid-May while players are playing Middle School baseball. During the "summer season" from around mid-May through mid-July, the number of reps in the form of games and practices will increase for even more player opportunities. All practices will take place in Kennett Square. The quality home field is available to play with lights for greater scheduling flexibility. A mixture of scrimmage games and tournaments will highlight the schedule. With the good number of competitive programs in the region, most games and tournaments will be within an easy drive of Kennett Square and will allow the use of -5 USSSA bats. Players will be graduating exclusively to -3 BBCOR Bats for middle school and 14u baseball.

The team will focus heavily on preparing kids to play at the next level. The team will spend a portion of the winter training under the Driveline training methods while also spending time working on the mental and psychological aspect of baseball, not just the physical side. Players are expected to play at least two defensive positions (one may include pitcher). Annual costs (for Fall, Winter, and Spring training and competition) typically are within the \$1,400-\$1,800 range which includes tournaments, umpiring, baseballs, insurance, etc.
